

Elementary Band Uniform

All band students will dress in a consistent and professional manner. This uniform is in line with what will be expected in junior high, high school, college, and professional life. A consistent appearance ensures that the focus of our concerts will be on the musical performances and not on any individual in the ensemble. ALL First Year Band and Second Year Band students must adhere to the dress code below when performing in any scheduled band performance.

Purchasing concert attire is the responsibility of the individual student and family.

Please reach out as soon as possible if you need assistance.

Donations of gently used clothing are often on hand and are gladly accepted.

White, button down, long-sleeve Oxford-style dress shirts, like the one shown. Shirts will be tucked in.
(no t-shirts, sleeveless or polo shirts).

Black dress slacks, or skirts, with boot cut, straight cut, or flat front.
(no jeans, no leggings, no yoga or stretch pants).

Black dress shoes with closed toes and black socks or hose.

(no gym shoes, no brightly colored shoes, no casual shoes, no flip-flops or open-toed shoes).

Full-black formal gowns are also acceptable.

Long black ties or black bow ties are also acceptable.

WOMP will provide black bow ties for Second Year Band students to wear at performances.

There are many places to find attire that meets these expectations. Many local and online retailers carry these items. (If you order online, make sure to leave time for delivery.) Examples: Walmart (George Flat Front Twill), Old Navy (black Boot Cut Khakis or Classic Straight pants), Forman Mills (various styles), Children's Place (Chino Pants or Uniform Basic Pants).
