<b>Miscellaneous</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• E-Learning day staff hours: 8:00am-3:30pm</li><li>• E-Learning day student hours: 8:30am-2:30pm</li><li>• Teachers will receive 50 minutes of planning time</li><li>• Teachers will receive 30 minutes for lunch</li><li>• Teachers will use additional time to provide student feedback when not monitoring</li><li>• student progress within the online instructional programs</li><li>• Balance "live" teaching time with JJH, specials, EL, LBS to elementary teachers</li></ul>
